Jørgen Roos Shows Greenland.

Director **Jørgen Roos** (1922-1998) contributed to the development of Danish documentary films throughout the course of half a century. He made his first film recordings in 1939, when documentary film had just come into being in Denmark. He shot c 200 films and won numerous international awards, e.g. a Golden Bear for "knud" at the 1996 Berlinale. Jørgen Roos and Nordic Film Days Lübeck had a close relationship for more than three decades. In 1992 the Film Days honoured him with an extensive retrospective.

"In his later years Roos explored his special interest in Greenland. He lost his heart to this exceptional country and he explored both the old and the new Greenland in many films. In these later films, Roos replaced the cool, detached view characteristic of his earlier films with a more engaged view. His films about Greenland highlighted his deep-felt commitment to the land which he, more than anyone else, has brought to the screen." (Ib Monty)
